Course Description:

This course emphasizes singing and performing techniques, beginning theory, analysis of music and the development of basic vocal technique. A general overview of music development through history and careers in music will also be studied. Participation in a concert performance is a requirement for the class grade. Students will learn proper breath support, good posture and diction. A variety of choral literature and songs in foreign languages will be studied.

- 6. Demonstrate music literacy.
- 7. Demonstrate vocal techniques and choral skills.
- 8. Identify and demonstrate expressive qualities of choral music.
